



Arctic Guardian 2024

Format, Gear Restrictions, and Round Count

- PISTOL:**
200rds per shooter
At least 3 mags
- Restricted to 9mm, .40S&W, .45 ACP
 - No magazines exceeding 20 rounds.
 - No IWB or shoulder holsters
 - No laser sights (red dot/reflex/hologram are OK)
 - Competitors may **NOT** share Pistols or magazines
- CARBINE:**
120rds per shooter
At least 3 mags
- Restricted to 5.56mm/.223 (no pistol caliber carbines)
 - MUST be fitted with a serviceable sling that supports muzzle control/discipline.
 - No magazines exceeding 30 rounds.
 - Suppressors are permissible.
 - Competitors may **NOT** share Carbines or magazines
- BOLT GUN:**
30rds per shooter
- Restricted to .308 (no 6mm, .243, 6.5mm etc.) **teammates MAY share rifle** (within team)
 - MUST be zeroed** prior to the event (No same-day zeroing unless authorized by Match Director- must be extreme extenuating circumstances for approval, which is highly unlikely)
 - MUST be fitted with a serviceable sling that supports muzzle control/discipline.
 - Suppressors are permissible.

2 SHOOTER TEAMS:

BOTH shoot **ALL** pistol stages.

BOTH shoot **ALL** carbine stages.

PRIMARY will shoot 2 of 4 bolt-gun stages **ALTERNATE** will shoot the remaining 2 stages.

IF A TEAM HAS A DROP AFTER REGISTRATION THE **DROPPING SHOOTER MUST EMAIL**
