

## Arctic Guardian 2024 Format, Gear Restrictions, and Round Count

PISTOL: -Restricted to 9mm, .40S&W, .45 ACP

**200rds** per shooter -No magazines exceeding 20 rounds.

At least 3 mags -No IWB or shoulder holsters

-No laser sights (red dot/reflex/hologram are OK)-Competitors may <u>NOT</u> share Pistols or magazines

**CARBINE**: -Restricted to 5.56mm/.223 (no pistol caliber carbines)

<u>120rds</u> per shooter -MUST be fitted with a serviceable sling that supports muzzle control/discipline.

At least 3 mags -No magazines exceeding 30 rounds.

-Suppressors are permissible.

-Competitors may **NOT** share Carbines or magazines

BOLT GUN: -Restricted to .308 (no 6mm, .243, 6.5mm etc.) <u>teammates MAY share rifle</u> (within team)

<u>30rds</u> per shooter - MUST be zeroed prior to the event (No same-day zeroing unless authorized by Match

Director- must be extreme extenuating circumstances for approval, which is highly unlikely)

-MUST be fitted with a serviceable sling that supports muzzle control/discipline.

-Suppressors are permissible.

## **2 SHOOTER TEAMS:**

**BOTH** shoot **ALL** pistol stages.

**BOTH** shoot **ALL** carbine stages.

**PRIMARY** will shoot 2 of 4 bolt-gun stages **ALTERNATE** will shoot the remaining 2 stages.
